
Spiritual Experiences from David's Psalms

- 2) List the four characteristics of the wicked from verses 1-4. How does this parallel with the world today?
- 3) What do we identify as the final destinies of the wicked and the righteous from verses 5-8?
- 4) What does verse 7 tell us about trusting in the right things; and what New Testament parallels can you identify.
- 5) What did David mean by referring to himself as "a green olive tree in the house of God"?
- 6) What are the characteristics of the righteous person and how can we apply that to our experience today?
