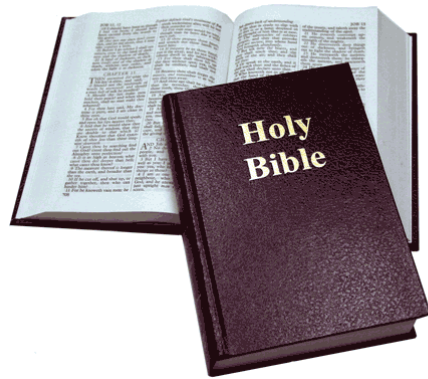


The Sermon on the Mount

STUDY 17

Reading: Matthew 6:11



- 1) The second group of three petitions in this prayer involve asking for things. *How does the first group we looked at last time in verses 9-10 prepare us to approach this next part correctly?*
- 2) What is the significance of Jesus' use of bread rather than any other commodity?
- 3) What other Bible examples of God's provision of bread can you think of that might strengthen the point that Jesus is making here?
- 4) What significance is there in the phrases 'give us' and 'this day'? What do they teach us about the principles of prayer?
- 5) When considering this verse, how do we determine what it is right to ask for and what is not? Is Jesus teaching us to lower our sights when we make our requests or is there a more important principle at stake?
- 6) How can this study change the way we approach prayer and then more generally the way we live day by day?
