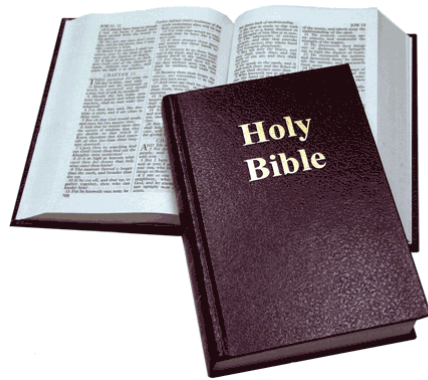


# The Sermon on the Mount

Home Fellowship Group Bible Study Questions

- 1) In the Lord's Prayer, why is sin pictured as a debt?
- 2) On the basis that this is a prayer that only Christians can really pray; why is it necessary for those who have been forgiven at the cross at conversion to continue asking for forgiveness?

**Read: Matthew 18:23-35**

- 3) What is the relationship between asking for forgiveness and giving forgiveness?

**So important is this issue that Jesus enlarges on it after he has finished the model prayer (see verses 14-15).**

- 4) This seems to imply that we forgive others in order that we can then receive God's forgiveness. *What exactly does Jesus mean here?*
- 5) It seems strange that in verse 13 we have to ask God not to lead us into temptation. *What is Jesus saying here?*
- 6) Are we right to ask for deliverance from evil when we believe that everything is within God's providence?
