

- 4) What is the difference between the two types of treasure Jesus is comparing?
- 5) Jesus is not condemning wealth and the Bible is clear that we should be good stewards. How do we determine the difference between having treasures on earth and crossing the line that Jesus is referring to?
- 6) What practical measures can we take to ensure that our heart in verse 21 is in the correct place?
