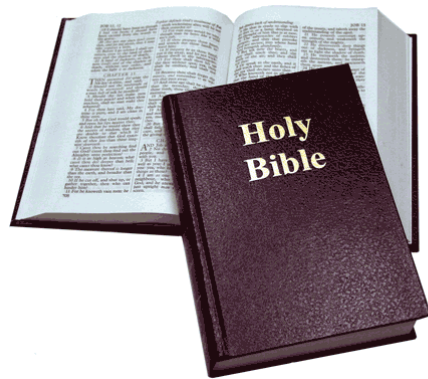

- 1) What does Jesus mean when He describes the eye as the lamp of the body in verse 22?
- 2) What point is Jesus making when He contrasts the healthy eye with the bad eye?
- 3) Jesus makes a powerful comparison between a body 'full of light' and one 'full of darkness'. *What practical steps can we take to ensure the first and avoid the second?*
- 4) What does Jesus mean when He says that we cannot serve two masters?
- 5) Jesus' use of the words 'hate' and 'love' in verse 24 seem very extreme. *What is the point that Jesus is making here?*
- 6) In Jesus example in verse 24 'God' and 'money' seem a random comparison. *What does Jesus mean here and why does it have to be an either/or?*
