

- 1) As with our previous study, this passage begins in verse 31 with the connecting word 'therefore'. What has Jesus stated in verses 25-30 that should reassure us that we need not be anxious about anything?
- 2) In verse 32 what is different in the thinking of the believer as opposed to the unbeliever?
- 3) What does it mean in verse 33 to 'seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness'?
- 4) The second part of verse 33 seems to suggest that the things 'added to you' are a reward. What is it that Jesus really means here?
- 5) In verse 34 Jesus appears to dismiss consideration of the future as unimportant. *What point do you think Jesus is making here?*
- 6) What practical steps can we make to obey the call of Jesus not to be anxious about our life?
