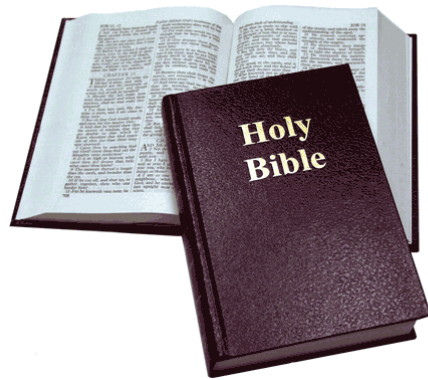


# The Sermon on the Mount

**In the Sermon on the Mount we have been told how we should live. Now the danger is that rather than examine our own progress, we examine other people's progress instead.**

- 1) In this passage, is Jesus telling us that there we should never make judgements at all?
- 2) What are the characteristics of the 'judgement' Jesus is speaking out against?
- 3) What does Jesus mean in verse 2 when He says that we will be judged with the same measure as we use to judge others?
- 4) What is the warning in verses 3-4 and how should it guard us against the wrong sort of judgement of others?
- 5) In verse 5; what is a hypocrite, and how are we to avoid being one?
- 6) How would you explain to someone what Jesus is teaching in verse 6?
