

- 1) How does Jesus' warning at the beginning of verse 15 link into what He has been teaching in the previous few verses?
- 2) What do false teachers look like; and what is the point that Jesus is making here?
- 3) What does Jesus mean when He says that we can recognise false teachers by their fruit?
- 4) When Jesus talks about a healthy tree and a diseased tree, what characteristics of the false teacher is He illustrating?
- 5) Verse 19 suggests a very drastic response. What is Jesus describing here?
- 6) Whilst majoring on the problem of false teachers, there are nevertheless lessons we can learn about true discipleship. What practical steps can we take to become those who are producing good fruit in our lives as Christians?
