

- 1) What is this story about building on rock and sand fundamentally about?
- 2) What do the rain, floods and winds represent in Jesus' illustration in verses 25 and 27?
- 3) What is Jesus' explaining when he describes two contrasting foundations for this building project?
- 4) What lessons are there for us from this passage in our Christians lives today?
- 5) Much of what Jesus had taught in this sermon must have made for uncomfortable listening. *What then is the significance of the general response to it all as described by Matthew in verses 28-29?*
- 6) As we come to the end of this series, what are the <u>general</u> and <u>specific</u> lessons you will have taken from it?
