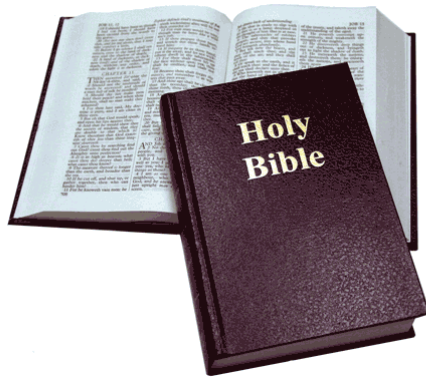

- 1) What do we mean by 'meekness' and how does our understanding of this differ from the world's view?
- 2) In what way does this beatitude tie in with being poor in spirit (v3)?
- 3) The result of being meek in the second half of verse 5 does not at first glance seem to fit. *What does Jesus mean by inheriting the earth?*
- 4) What does Jesus mean in verse 6 as 'righteousness'?
- 5) What other things that people hunger and thirst after today do Christians also seek; things that although not bad in themselves take our focus off the promise of being satisfied?
- 6) What does Jesus mean when He says that those who hunger and thirst after righteousness will be satisfied?
