
Joshua – The man and the message

We left our last study with the declaration that "tomorrow the LORD will do wonders among you".

- 1) If seems that God withheld the details of exactly what would happen until the morning of the crossing itself. *What does this omission suggest?*
- 2) Notice a recurring statement in verses 4, 7 and 10? What does this tell us about how God is working here?
- 3) In verse 7 what does God mean when He says that He will exalt Joshua?
- 4) What does Joshua's speech to the people in verses 9-13 tell us about the man and his leadership?
- 5) Verse 13 tells us that the miracle of the crossing of the Jordan depended on the priests stepping into the river in full flood. *How can we relate that call to living the Christian life today?*
- 6) Sceptics might doubt the miracle of verse 13; as indeed they would the river bed suddenly being dry enough for all these people to cross (v17). What is the answer to this objection in verse 13?
