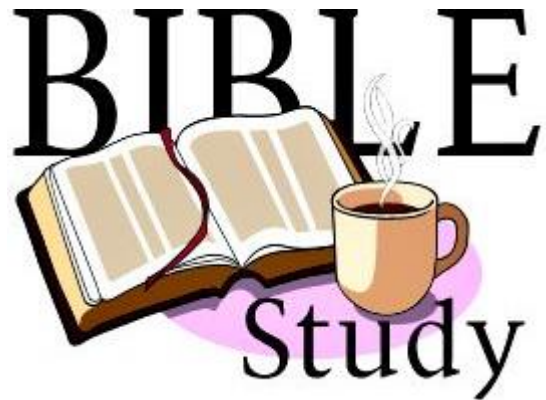

1) Why do some people find the miraculous events in the Bible difficult to believe? On what basis do we believe them?

Verse 16 tells us that “the waters coming down... rose up in a heap” and the waters “flowing down toward the Sea ...were completely cut off”:

2) What two essential things happened in the previous two verses before God acted? What does this teach us?

3) The fords in Joshua 2:7 suggest that crossing the Jordan was usually possible in some places. *What does this passage tell us about the timing of God’s work in the lives of His people?*

4) What does verse 16 reveal about the extent of this miracle?

5) What is the significance of the priests’ actions in verse 17?

6) Apart from the obvious need to cross the river, why else did God perform the miracles we see in these verses?
