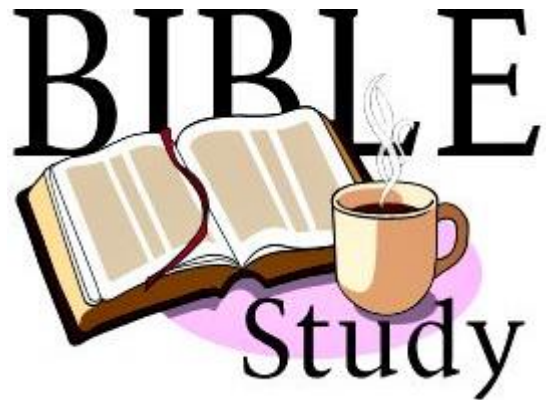

- 2) What is the significance of the way that this man was standing before Joshua?
- 3) How do you explain the answer to Joshua's question about whose side the man with a sword was on?
- 4) What does the second half of verse 14 tell us about Joshua's conclusions concerning this appearance?
- 5) What is the significance of the words of the commander of the Lord's army in verse 15?
- 6) How might this passage help us see how the Lord appears to His people today?
