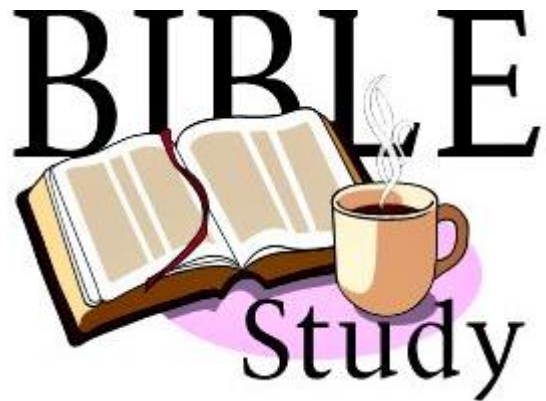


# Joshua – The man and the message

Tuesday 3rd/Wednesday 4th March 2015

- 1) Verse 1 seems to break the flow of the encounter between Joshua and the Lord begun in 5:13 and resumed in 6:2. *Why is this opening verse so important?*
- 2) Why does God command His people to invade Canaan and destroy those who oppose them?
- 3) God’s instructions for the conquest of Jericho in verses 3-5 seem unusual. *What arguments could you use against it being an effective strategy?*
- 4) What is the significance of the number seven in verse 4?
- 5) Why in verse 5 will a shout bring the walls down; rather than some physical attack carried out by the people?
- 6) What lessons do we learn in this passage about the Christian life?
