
Joshua – The man and the message

- 1) Having been told to remain silent throughout the previous week; why were the people to shout at this particular point?
- 2) In verses 17-18, what does Joshua mean when he refers to things being 'devoted to the Lord'?
- 3) If God was giving the city to Israel; why in verse 17 was most of it to be destroyed?
- 4) It may seem strange in the circumstances that it is a prostitute who would be saved. *Why was this the case?*
- 5) Verses 18-19 include clear instructions about what should be destroyed. Why was it necessary to enlarge on what had already been commanded in verse 17?

6) How do verses 20-21 help us to see the connection between what God does, and what He expects us to do, in accomplishing His will?
