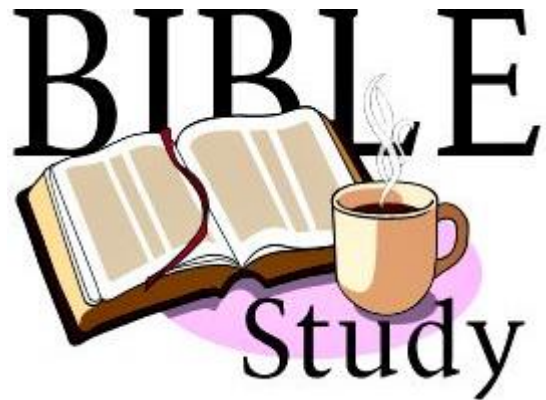


Joshua – The man and the message

The significance of this passage is quite difficult to see at first glance. It is, however, helpful to approach it with the themes of judgement and salvation in mind.

- 1) Based on the comment above; why is Rahab such a wonderful example of God's grace?
- 2) Why in verse 23 is Rahab and her household put “outside the camp of Israel”; yet in verse 25 we find that she then lived “in Israel”?
- 3) What role does Rahab go on to play in history?
- 4) In verse 24 the people carry out God’s command concerning the plunder. *What was the reason for this action?*
- 5) Why in verse 26 was Jericho never to be rebuilt? Do we know whether this command was observed?
- 6) What does this passage teach us about how God works?
