

- 1) It is hard to find a greater contrast between the events of chapters 6 and 7. *What are the key turning points here?*
- 2) What does the confidence of verses 2-3 tell us about the spies that Joshua sent to Ai?
- 3) The events in verses 4-5 arguably undo much of the work done in the lives and thinking of the people of Israel. *What is happening here?*
- 4) In verses 6-8 we seem to have a completely different Joshua to the one in the previous six chapters. *What do these verses tell us about Joshua's response to this unexpected defeat?*
- 5) In verse 9 Joshua indicates some serious consequences to what has happened in this passage. *What does this tell us about Joshua at this point?*

6) What does this passage teach us as God's people today?
