

- 3) Why at the beginning of verse 12 does there have to be a 'therefore' in response to this sin?
- 4) In verse 19 Joshua calls Achan to confess his sins. What is the nature of that sin in verses 20-21?
- 5) The sentence on Achan and his family is severe. What does it teach us about God's judgement?
- 6) How is verse 26 a positive end to the story; and what does it tell us concerning the gospel?
