

Read: Joshua 8:1-2

1) After dealing with Achan's sin, Israel's relationship with God is restored. What familiar phrases do we find in verses 1-2 that reveal things being back on track?

2) If Joshua is fighting 'a battle already won'; how can we apply that to Christian living?

3) In God's instructions for the treatment of Ai in verse 2 He uses the pattern of the taking of Jericho; with one exception. *Why have the instructions changed?*

Read: Joshua 8:3-17

4) Verses 3-17 describe the preparation for taking Ai. *How is this different from the previous attempt?*

Read: Joshua 8:18-27

5) Verses 18-26 describe the victory over the city of Ai. What is the significance of Joshua's javelin; and what other famous battle is this a reminder of?

6) What does this chapter reveal about what Joshua and the Israelites have learnt during this episode?
