

- 3. What does Jesus mean in verses 13-14 when he talks about being His friends?
- 4. In verse 15 we might be surprised that Jesus' disciples are not to be known any longer as servants. What does Jesus mean?
- 5. In verse 16 Jesus expresses both the fact that he chooses us and the purpose for it. What are we to learn from this verse?
- 6. In verse 16 we once again we have a comment on prayer. How are we to explain God giving us everything we ask him for?
