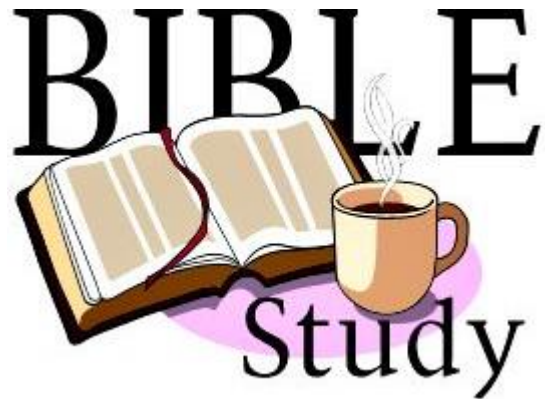

2. Verse 13 is often quoted when we think of soldiers giving their lives in war. However, what is Jesus specifically describing here?
3. What does Jesus mean in verses 13-14 when he talks about being His friends?
4. In verse 15 we might be surprised that Jesus' disciples are not to be known any longer as servants. What does Jesus mean?
5. In verse 16 Jesus expresses both the fact that he chooses us and the purpose for it. What are we to learn from this verse?
6. In verse 16 we once again we have a comment on prayer. How are we to explain God giving us everything we ask him for?
