

- 1. What does Jesus mean by the term 'the world'; and what does it mean in verse 19 to be 'of the world'?
- 2. How do verses 18-20 help us understand the world's opposition to the Christian faith?
- 3. What does Jesus mean when He says that people will do these things 'on account of my name'?
- 4. How are we to understand Jesus' words in verses 22 and 24?
- 5. How does the Old Testament quote in verse 25 help us see what is happening here?
- 6. How has this passage helped you understand the world's opposition to the gospel and towards Christians?
