

- 3) How are we to understand verse 2 in terms of the role of the Father and Son in salvation?
- 4) Verse 3 is clearly an important declaration of the gospel. What does it mean to 'know' the true God and His Son Jesus?
- 5) Jesus' statement in verse 4 is set in the past tense. What is the accomplished work that He is referring to?
- 6) In verse 5, how is the Son to be glorified in the presence of the Father? What is the glory that they shared before the world existed?
