
"On the night when He was betrayed..."

Having given a dramatic demonstration of His love for them, Jesus now gives His disciples a model of love that they are to follow. He does not wait for the disciples to answer His question in verse 12; but proceeds to answer it Himself.

- 1) Why does Jesus refer the disciples to those two specific titles: Lord and Teacher?
- 2) What does verse 14 tell us about the relationship between Jesus and those who follow Him?
- 3) What is it that Jesus wants His disciples to do in verse 15?
- 4) Why is it necessary for Jesus to include the words of verse 16?
- 5) In verse 17; what does it mean that those who follow this example will be blessed?
- 6) How can we apply the practical lessons of this passage in our lives today?
