

- 4) What is unique about Jesus' prayer in verse 10: "All mine are yours, and yours are mine..."?
- 5) What does Jesus mean in verse 10 when He says that He is glorified in the disciples?
- 6) In verse 11 Jesus begins to pray for the disciples' protection. What is that first area of protection?
