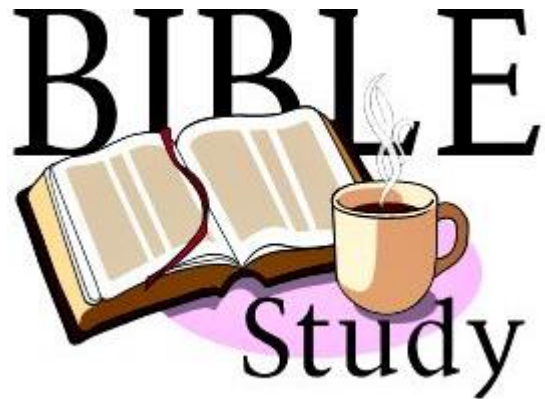

Tuesday 20th/Wednesday 21st October 2015

- 1) In verses 31-32; what does Jesus mean when He says that both He and His Father are about to be glorified?
- 2) Look at verses 33 & 36. What does Jesus mean when He says “Where I am going you cannot come”; and then “you will follow afterwards”?
- 3) Why is the commandment to love one another described in verse 34 as being ‘new’?
- 4) Why will this love lead people to recognise that we are Jesus’ disciples?
- 5) What does the exchange in verses 37-38 tell us about Peter’s understand of what is happening?
- 6) In what practical ways can we carry out this New Commandment from Jesus?
