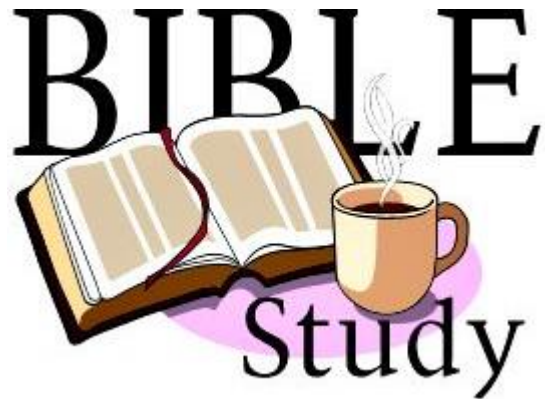

Obedience flowing from love

Home Fellowship Group Bible Study Questions

Tuesday 12th/Wednesday 13th January 2016

As we come to this next section it is important to bear two things in mind. Firstly, Jesus is speaking to His disciples. Secondly, He is explaining what will happen after the Holy Spirit has been given.

- 1) In verse 21, Jesus appears to suggest that obedience is required before we can know Him. How are we to understand this verse?

- 2) Judas does not grasp what Jesus is saying. What is his concern in verse 22?

- 3) Does Jesus' answer Judas' question in verse 23? If so, how?

- 4) In verse 23; how are we to understand the Father and Son making their home with us?

- 5) Bearing in mind the caution surrounding our first question, what is the significance of Jesus pressing home the theme of obedience in verse 24?

- 6) What practical steps might we take to love Christ more deeply and obey Him more readily?
