- 3) In this chapter, Judah becomes the prominent brother and spokesman. What is the significance of this in the wider story?

- 5) In verses 30-34 we have the second part of Judah's speech. What does it teach us about the subject of 'substitution'?
- 6) In this passage, Judah recalls the covenant he had made with his father back in Genesis 43:8-9. What does this passage tell us about a far greater covenant?
