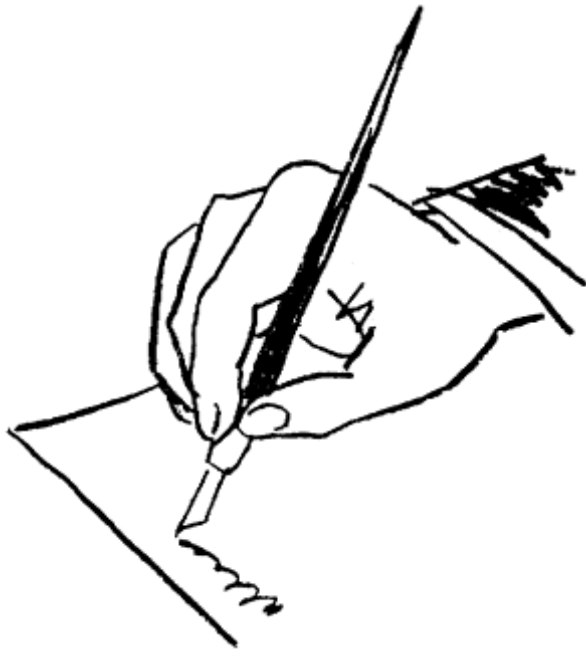

- 1) Why does John describe the soldiers' actions in verses 23-24?
- 2) What spiritual application might John be thinking about as he describes the handling of the tunic?
- 3) What is the significance of John's list of those who were present at the crucifixion?
- 4) What do we learn here about Jesus' mother Mary? Why does he address her as 'woman'?
- 5) The gospel writers record seven sayings of Jesus from the cross; of which this is the third. What are the other six?
- 6) What do we learn from what Jesus says to Mary and John in verses 26-27?
