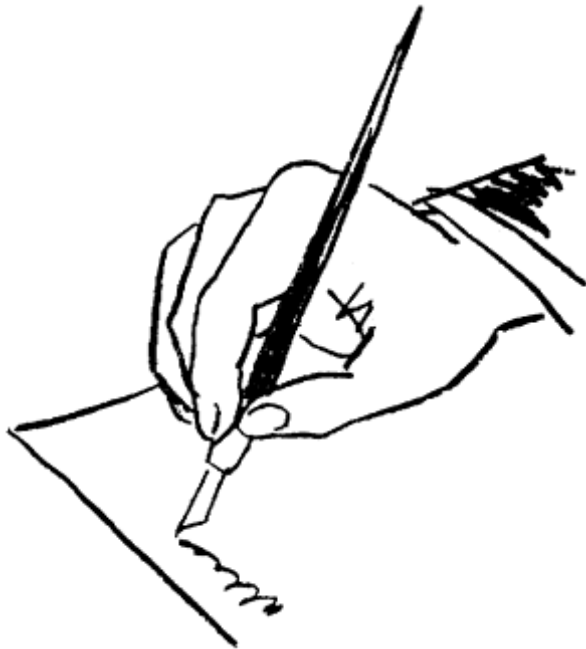

- 4) What lesson from this fishing expedition are these disciples to learn concerning their future work?

- 5) What is the key part that John plays in this event; even though he only mentions himself briefly (see verse 7)?

- 6) There is something very special about this breakfast on the beach. What do verses 9-14 teach us?
